Clearview Career Engagement Facilitator, Candace Maruk, will be coming to the school for the afternoon of Wednesday, April 9 to make a presentation to our junior high students on career readiness, goal setting and trends in the workplace.

Mrs. Chick has organized our school Book Fair and the fun dress up activities that run with it for this week. Thank you, Mrs. Chick, for all of your hard work. The **Book Fair Family Night** is scheduled for Thursday, April 10 from 3:00 - 7:00. All community members are welcome.

Our grade **6 - 9 dance will be held on Friday, April 11th** from 7 - 10:00. Students from other local schools have been invited to attend. The cost is \$5. There will also be a concession stand with most items at \$2 each.

We have a **PD Day** scheduled for **April 22nd**. There will be no school that day. Erskine teachers will join other teachers in our division to focus on numeracy and literacy teaching and assessment skills. Staff recertified in First Aid during our March professional development day.

Grade 9 students will tour Wm E Hay Stettler Secondary Campus and meet with their staff on April 24 to discuss their choices for high school courses. Registration forms will be due to our office April 28.

Farm Safety presentations have been scheduled for Monday, April 28 for our Kindergarten to grade 6 students.

Our **Junior High Ottawa, Montreal and Quebec Field Trip** is scheduled for April 28 - May 4. Thank you to all of our school community members that have supported our group and individual fund-raisers to make this trip possible. Students that are not attending the trip are expected to attend school as both the travellers and non-travellers will have projects and assignments to complete that week.

Mental Health week will be celebrated at the school from May 5 - 9. Each day has its own activity; Monday - Chalk it Up, Tuesday - Taco Bout Tuesday, Wednesday - Hats on For Mental Health, Thursday - Movement Break, and Friday - Friendship Friday

Grade 9 Farewell has been scheduled for **Tuesday**, **May 13**. The grade 9's will begin planning for the event determining caterer, venue, etc.,..

Grade 9 students will be writing **PAT Exams** in all core subjects in **May and June**. Teachers in these subject areas will start sending home information packages preparing students for these exams. **Grade 6** students will write **PAT Exams** for language arts, mathematics and social studies. Although our grade 5 and 6 students have been combined for social studies, our grade 5 students will not need to write this exam.

We have begun planning for **Indigenous Day** on **June 20th** and are looking for stories and pictures from families in our community to celebrate our local and personal histories. If you have a story or family history that you would like to share with our school community, please contact the school office. Also just a reminder to families that have an indigenous background, if you complete a declaration and self identify for our school's registration process you can ensure additional funding dollars to our school. If your family fits this category, please give our office a call.

Planning for next year has begun as we look at our enrolments and budget considerations. We are planning on maintaining our current staff, but there will be slight changes. We will once again need to look at areas where we can combine some of our classes. We are also needing to plan for our **pre-k classes**. Parents are encouraged to register by May 23rd if they plan on having their son or daughter attend at any point in the school year.
